BEIJING - XIAMEN (9- DAY)

Itinerary

Day 1 Arrive in Beijing

Welcome to China's capital city. Hotel rooms are available for check-in. Welcome Dinner will be prepared in the evening.

Day 2 Beijing

Full-day sightseeing starts with a visit to the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games Sites and Bird's Nest Stadium. Enjoy a traditional tea ceremony, and continue to the Tiananmen Square, The Forbidden City. Tonight, consider joining an optional tour to see a dramatic Chinese Kung Fu Show.

Day 3 Beijing (Performance on the Great Wall)

Begin the day with a visit to the biggest jade factory. Visit the Great Wall of China and perform on the Great Wall. This evening, Beijing Roast Duck dinner will be arranged to celebrate the day.

Day 4 Beijing

This morning, enjoy a rickshaw tour of Hutong. You are invited into the courtyard of a local family's home for lunch. After lunch, visit the Capital Museum of China.

Day 5 Beijing - Xiamen

Learn traditional Tai Chi to start the day. A short flight brings you to the city of Xiamen in south China.

Day 6 Xiamen

Xiamen is a city that has a complementary balance of cultural and historical. Sightseeing begins with a visit to the Huli Hill Fort and the White Deer Cave. This afternoon, visit Xiamen University.

Day 7 Xiamen (Exchange Day)

Visit a local school and meet with Chinese teachers and students. Arrange a science course for both Canadian and Chinese. After lunch, friendly matches will be held between two schools' teams. After dinner, a music exchange concert will be arranged.

Day 8 Xiamen

This morning, take ferry to visit Gulangyu Island. Gulangyu is famous for hosting China's only piano museum, giving it the nickname of "Piano Island" or "The Town of Pianos" or "The Island of Music". High-lights include cobbled lanes, period architecture, and eateries of various descriptions.

Day Xiamen
